### Refilling Nippon-ink Cartridge procedure for NP-LC 38 / 67 Series.



### Instruction and Procedure – 4 Simple Steps

- 1) **Picture 1** – Locate the colour stopper at the back of the cartridge.
- 2) **Picture 2** – There are 2 stoppers, **refill the ink from the top colour stopper** while the bottom Orange stopper is using as Bleeding Hole to allow the air and bubble to escape. **The Orange Stopper to be removed before Installation.** Thus it prevent ink spillage, ink purge out from the refilling hole, bubble generated and/or ink can settle down faster.
- 3) **Picture 3** – Need to slant or tilt the cartridge at an angle estimated about 30 to 45 degrees before refilling it. It helps the ink to flow down faster due to gravity and allow the air and bubble to escape from the Bleeding hole without any spillage. **User must pump the ink slowly from the syringe.**
- 4) **Picture 4** – Reinstall the colour stoppers at the back of the cartridge, ready for use.

*Note: Need to tape the nozzle before refill, to prevent ink leakage. User must ensure tape been removed from nozzle before installing the refill cartridge to the printer.*
